LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Congress Returns to Session

ABATE is dedicated to preserving the rights of all motorcyclists, regardless of what you ride. We encourage everyone to become involved in the legislative and political processes to protect our freedom to ride. Get involved by joining ABATE, register to vote, contact your legislators, and stay informed of legislative issues concerning your motorcycle rights.

MRF has purchased CQ engage software, this software helps "robo call" for our call to actions to our specific reps/senators. They can also help us on a state level with specific issues directly related to Texas. Please visit the MRF web site (MRF.org) & complete the "Call to Actions" they have listed if you have not already done so.

We need to be aggressive with federal bills. Contact your reps/senators.

Anti-profiling and Autocycle bills are needed! Bills must be pre-filed in 10 months. It is vital to contact our representatives to make them aware of Bikers Inside the Beltway on May 15th, help set an appointment to visit with them on May 15th...

Continue monitoring SB754 spending. Work hard on federal bills, especially H Res. 318 and S Resolution 154--both anti-profiling resolutions (resolutions, not bills). We will be busy on State legislation in 6 months; we only have 5 state meetings before Legislative Day '19 in Austin!

2018 State ABATE goals:

- 1) Stay aggressive with anti-profiling legislation in Texas;
- 2) Stay aggressive with monitoring the 0501 Safety Fund account (84th) SB-754 & accountability for Gov. Veto (SB 1);
- 3) Increase membership. A percentage of our memberships expire every month. We need to take that into account.
